Opening Statement

“Here we are. A tough loss, obviously we didn’t play very well in the first half, way too many penalties and mistakes. The second half we came out and did some good things, and gosh we had a shot there at the end, had an errant ball and here we are. It’s a disappointing outcome.”

“We weren’t putting a lot of pressure on him (Potter). The hard thing is we’re not winning a lot of those one-on-one battles, and the thing is at the end you play high-risk defense.

“You’re coming after them. It definitely worked at the end, but it’s one of those deals where you’re trying to protect certain things, you’re trying to be aggressive at different times and they did a good job of keeping us off balance on defense, max protecting, keeping guys in and then being able to take some of those big shots.”

“Tonight we had a great shot at the end. You’re sitting there at the very end of the game, and you got a wide open guy down there around the 15, you got to hit him. We hit him, we have a couple more plays left and we’re in striking distance.”
