### **San Jose State University Football Game Notes**

Game captains were #2-**Tim Crawley**, #4-**Christian Tago**, #5-**Kenny Potter**, #10-Maurice McKnight.

The game featured nine plays of 30 or more yards. San Jose State had five of them – three of which were touchdowns. The first was a 75-yard scoring run by **Zamore Zigler**, a 65-yard touchdown pass play from **Kenny Potter** to **Tim Crawley** and a 45-yard swing pass from Potter to **Deontae Cooper** for six points. **Justin Holmes** caught a 31-yard pass in the first quarter and a 41-yard pass in the second.

**Dominic Fredrickson** made his first major college start. Fredrickson started at left guard with **Jeremiah Kolone** moving over to start at center for **Keoni Taylor**.

**Mark Amann** started at a linebacker position in his first major college start and led all players with a single-game career-high 14 tackles.

**Eugene Taylor** made his first start of the season. Taylor played a defensive end position and was in on five tackles.

**Zamore Zigler's** 75-yard touchdown run in the New Mexico game was his longest of the season. Zigler scored on a 74-yard run in the Portland State win.

**Tim Crawley** had his third multi-touchdown game of his career. His 65-yard touchdown reception was his longest as a Spartan. Crawley scored three touchdowns in the 2015 game at Nevada and twice in the 2013 loss to San Diego State.

**Deontae Cooper** scored two touchdowns in a game for the second time in his career and first in a San Jose State uniform. Like Crawley, Cooper scored back-to-back San Jose State touchdowns. His fourth quarter sores were a 2-yard run followed by a 45-yard pass play in front of the Spartan sideline.

**Kenny Potter** threw for at least 300 yards for the first time this season in the New Mexico game and the fourth time in his Spartan career. The Spartans' 314 passing yards were a season high.

Defensive tackle **Owen Roberts** had a single-game career best nine tackles and a tackle for loss against New Mexico. His previous best was seven stops in the season opener at Tulsa.

**Bryce Crawford's** streak of scoring on all his kick scoring attempts ended when he missed an extra point attempt after the Spartans' second touchdown. Crawford had converted four field goals and 14 PATs before his miss. Crawford later missed a 29-yard field goal try in the second quarter.

Safety **Maurice McKnight** came up with his second interception of the season to initiate a fourth-quarter touchdown drive.

For just the second time this season, San Jose State gave up fewer than 10 points off of turnovers. New Mexico scored on Austin Ocasio's 37-yard interception return in the third quarter.

**Michael Carrizosa** had a season best 55.5 yard punting average and the Spartans had a single-game season-best 48.2 yards net punting average.

New Mexico's 446 rushing yards matched the eighth most yards allowed by San Jose State in a game. Virginia rushed for 446 yards in a 1998 win over the Spartans.
