Opening Statement

"Great win on the road. The one thing that we can't do is take wins for granted anytime. After the last two weeks, it feels great to go in the locker room and celebrate with out players."

"We found a way to win. To me, that's when it's most difficult and when you really shine is when people are pushing against you. Our guys didn't listen to that, they kept believing, fought and went out and won this football game."

"One of the things that I saw in this game is something that's indefinable and that's mojo. You could feel that in the third quarter. In practice, we talked about the third quarter being our quarter. Regardless of the score we were going to find a way to win. These guys found mojo and played off each other."

"If you're a good football team, and I think we still have a good football team, I think our guys showed that again today. "

On the opening drive of the third quarter:

"It was huge. We had a few drives in there that were 15 or 16 play drives. One of the goals in the game was to have extended drives. We talked about it on the offensive side is playing offense. We want to strike, we want to score, we want to put points on the board. We want to play offense. We want to help out our defense."

On stopping Tyler Ervin:

"To contain the type of back Tyler Ervin is, on the defensive side, we won that battle, and that's exactly what we set out to do."

On the second half:

"We're either going to go finish this game and get to the fourth quarter and win it ... or we're not. It's time to put you're foot in the ground and go play, and I thought that's what our guys did. To me whatever came out of halftime with our players, there was some mojo that followed, and it showed up in the second half."
