San Jose State University Football Game Notes

San Jose State remains winless against Pac-12 member schools since the 2006 win at home over Stanford. The Spartans now have 12 consecutive losses against Pac-12 member schools.

San Jose State has three takeaways this season on two interceptions and a fumble recovery. The Spartans have converted all three into touchdowns – two of them in the Oregon State game.

San Jose State's 253 yards of total offense was a season low.

The Oregon State game marked the second time this season three San Jose State quarterbacks played in the game. Kenny Potter started and was replaced when injured by Joe Gray. Malik Watson finished the game for the Spartans. The three quarterbacks played in the season-opening victory over New Hampshire.

Keenan Sykes made his first appearance of the season and was a starter at a defensive tackle position. Sykes did not play in the first two games while recuperating from a preseason injury.

For the third consecutive game this season, Tyler Ervin scored at least two touchdowns. Ervin scored on runs of 4 and 6 yards in the first half. He leads the team in scoring with 42 points.

Tyler Ervin became the San Jose State career leader for kickoff return yardage in the Oregon State game. He entered the game in fourth place with 1,796 yards and passed former career leader Deoncé Whitaker's total of 1,837 yards with his third return in the first half. Ervin finished the game with five returns for 109 yards and now has 1,905 kickoff return yards.

Defensive end Isaiah Irving was credited a career high 2.5 tackles for loss in the first half. As a freshman in 2013, Irving was credited 2.0 tackles for loss in the Wyoming win and in the triple overtime loss to Navy.

Punter Michael Carrizosa had seven punts of 50 or more yards in the Oregon State game. Carrizosa had punts of 50, 55, 54 and 62 yards in the first half and 66, 60 and 52 yards in second half. For the season, Carrizosa has six punts of 60 or more yards.

Tyler Winston extended his streak of catching at least one pass in a game to 24 consecutive games with a first quarter reception. His 6-yard touchdown reception in the second quarter was his first score in 2015.

Cleveland Wallace, III, came up with his first interception of the season and his second in his San Jose State career in the second quarter.
