Post-Game Notes vs. San Jose State (11/21/14)

TEAM NOTES

- * Utah State improved to 6-0 at home this season, tying the 2012 team for the most home wins in a single-season in school history. Overall, it is just the fifth time in the 47-year history of Romney Stadium that a USU team has gone undefeated at home joining the 1968 (4-0), 1972 (5-0), 1982 (4-0) and 2012 (6-0) teams.
- * Utah State has now won nine-straight home games, which is tied with the 1910-12, 1934-36 and 2012-13 teams for the fifth-longest home winning streak in school history.
- * Utah State's nine wins this season are tied with the 1960, 1961 and 2013 teams for the second-most wins in school history, trailing the 2012 team that won a school-record 11 games.
- * Utah State has won nine-straight home games and 18 of its last 20 home games overall, including seven straight Mountain West home games and 12 of its last 13 conference home games overall.
- * Under head coach Matt Wells, Utah State is now 10-2 at home, including a 7-1 league record.
- * Utah State is now 130-98 all-time in Romney Stadium.
- * Utah State has won 11 of its last 12 Mountain West games and 24 of its last 26 conference games overall. All-time, USU is 13-2 in Mountain West play.
- * Utah State has won a school-record 15 straight games in November and 19 of its last 21 November games overall, including nine straight at home.
- * Utah State's defense did not force a turnover for just the second time this year and for just the third time in its last 35 games.
- * Utah State improved to 68-37-3 all-time on Senior Day as this year's senior class extended its school record with its 36th win.
- * Utah State's defense has allowed just seven second-half points in its last four games and just 36 second-half points in its last eight games.
- * Utah State is now 9-0 on the season and 17-2 under head coach Matt Wells when it scores 20-plus points in a game as USU scored a season-high 41 points tonight. USU also improved to 6-1 this year and 14-2 under Wells when allowing less than 20 points.
- * Utah State rushed for a season-high 313 yards and had 421 yards of total offense, marking the seventh time this year that USU has had at least 400 yards of total offense.
- * Utah State had a season-low 108 passing yards and limited San Jose State to just 61 passing yards, which is the fewest by an Aggie opponent since Weber State had 34 passing yards in 2013.
- * Utah State improved to 2-0 on the season and has now won 17 straight games with a 100-yard rusher. USU has also now won 18 of its last 19 games when it rushes at least 40 times in a game as USU rushed the ball 42 times tonight.
- * Utah State has now won six straight games against San Jose State, its longest winning streak in series history.
- * Utah State improved to 10-1 over the last two seasons with a freshman quarterback as Kent Myers improved to 4-0 as a starter.
- * Utah State has led at the half in 32 of its last 40 games and is now 28-4 in those games.
- * Utah State has now led at the end of the first quarter in 31 of its last 40 games and is now 26-5 in those games.
- * Utah State has held 31 of its last 40 opponents out of the end zone in the first quarter, including six opponents this year, and 23 of its last 40 opponents scoreless in the first quarter.
