TEAM NOTES

- Navy is now 4-0 this season when scoring 30 or more points and 35-9 under Ken Niumatalolo.
- The Mids rushed for 423 yards on 68 carries ... it's the third time this season Navy has topped 400 yards rushing ... the 423 yards are the 27th most in program history.
- Navy's fumble on the opening drive of the game marked its 13th turnover of the year after turning the ball over just 10 times all of last season ... it's the ninth lost fumble by the Mids this season.
- Navy's 17-play drive (2:43) that ended with a 20-yard field goal by Austin Grebe (:00, 2Qtr) was the Mids' longest of the year in terms of number of plays ... the previous long was a 14-play drive (6:26) against Temple that ended in a 3-yard TD run by Keenan Reynolds
- Navy's 13-play, 98-yard drive that ended in a 2-yard touchdown run by Keenan Reynolds was the longest drive of the year in terms of yards ... the previous long was a 4-play, 84-yard drive that was capped by a 1-yard TD run by Keenan Reynolds in the opener against nationally-ranked Ohio State.
- There were just two penalties called in the game, both on San Jose State ... it's the eighth time since 2002 that Navy has had zero penalties in a game and the first since last year's Notre Dame game (11-2).
- Navy came into the game scoring on 23 of its 30 red zone trips ... the Mids for 7 for 7 against San Jose State.
- Navy's defense came up with a season-high 6 tackles for a loss ... its previous best was 5 against Ohio State in the opener.
- San Jose State threw for 322 yards, marking the second time this season the Mids have surrendered 300-plus yards through the air. Western Kentucky connected on 58 of its 54 passes for 387 yards.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Kwazel Bertrand, Jr., Rover

- Intercepted Joe Gray's pass at the Navy 3-yard line and returned in 11 yards (13:41, 1Qtr) ... it was his first career pick.
- · Also contributed the second-most tackles with seven.

Austin Grebe, Jr., K

• Attempted and made his first career field goal, a 20-yarder as time expired in the first half ... also connected on a 33-yarder in the fourth quarter (3:06).

Keenan Revnolds, Jr., QB

- Broke the school record for career touchdowns with his 50th on an 8-yard run (7:51, 1Qtr) ... tacked on additional TD runs of 3 (4:56, 2Qtr) and 2 yards (5:49, 3Qtr) for 52 over his three seasons ... Ricky Dobbs was the previous record holder with 49 from 2008-10.
- The touchdown also pushed his streak to 14 consecutive games with a rushing touchdown which is a school record. It is also the longest active streak in the country by a player at any position.
- On Navy's 98-yard drive that resulted in a 2-yd TD run by Reynolds (5:49, 3Qtr), Reynolds accounted for 93 of the 98 yards.
- Finished the game with a career-best 251 yards on 39 carries ... his previous high was 240 yards against San Jose State last year and his previous high in carries was 36 in the same game.
- The 251 yards rushing are the most by a Navy player since Shun White ran for a school-record 348 yards against Towson on 8-30-08.
- The 39 carries are the most by a Navy player since Ricky Dobbs came off to the bench and carried the ball 42 times in a soaking rainstorm against SMU on 10-25-08.
- It was his third career 200-yard rushing game which stands third in program history behind 5 by Chris McCoy (1995-97) and 4 by Napoleon McCallum, 1981-85.
- Two of his three 200-yard rushing games have come against San Jose State as he rushed for a career-best 240 yards against the Spartans in last year's triple overtime win. He is the first San Jose State opponent to record multiple 200-yard rushing games against the Spartans in the school's history.
- Reynolds' line against San Jose State over the last two years: 75 carries for 491 yards and 10 rushing touchdowns, while completing 8 of 13 passes for 102 yards and a TD
- Meanwhile, it was the 11th time in his career he has topped 100 yards rushing and the third time this season. He owns the second-most 100-yard rushing games by an active quarterback behind Ohio State's Braxton Miller (out for the season) who has amassed 14.
- With a trio of touchdowns, he also became the school's record holder for most points responsible for in a career with 428. Ricky Dobbs was the previous record holder with 414 points scored between 2008-10.
- Moved into seventh on Navy's career rushing leader board with 2634 yards ... needs just 31 yards to tie fifth-place Ricky Dobbs (2665).
- Reynolds came into the game tied with four other players for No. 1 in the country in rushing touchdowns by a quarterback this season ... with three more today, he owns 11 on the year.
- After scoring three or more touchdowns in seven games a year ago, he scored three TDs for the first time this season.
