North Dakota Head Coach Bubba Schweigert:

Opening Statement

“There’s so much that we need to do to get better. We’re going to address those things and going to stick with this plan, its one day at a time.”

“We talked to our guys and we’re not one bit concerned about the scoreboard. This might seem odd, but we are concerned about who we are and how we play, whether it’s the first quarter or second quarter. We talked to our guys and we should never know what the score is when we play. That’s what we are going to evaluate tomorrow, whether we are playing with the heart, effort and desire to get better.”

“We are going to be a team that improves a lot, I really believe that. We had 27 guys on this trip that had never traveled to a UND football game and 10 of those are true freshman. We look for those guys, if they stay the course and keep listening, I think we’re going to improve a lot.”

“We talked about the first half. We’re close on the first touchdown, we just missed a pick and then we missed a pick six when its 14-0. That changes the game a lot. Those two plays are real close, we didn’t make them so then you get the result you get. But close doesn’t get it done.”

“Overall I’m pleased with our effort. I was disappointed in the fourth quarter. I thought we let the scoreboard effect us a little bit where it shouldn’t. We’re not where we’re at in our program and what we want to establish. As long as this staff is together, the scoreboard should never effect our effort and how we play.”
