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San Jose State University Football Game Notes

San Jose State's game captains for the fourth game in a row are defensive tackle Travis Raciti, quarterback David Fales, linebacker Keith Smith and offensive guard Ryan Jones.

Bené Benwikere returned to the starting lineup at a cornerback position after missing the Hawaii game. He teamed with Dasheon Frierson as the starting cornerbacks against Colorado State. In the Hawaii game, Frierson opened with Damon Ogburn, Jr., as the starting cornerbacks.

San Jose State had a season-high 608 yards of total offense.

Austin Lopez made it eight games in a row with a field goal when he opened the scoring in the Colorado State game with a 26-yard conversion. Lopez went 2-for-2 and is 11-of-13 for the season.

The David Fales to Jarrod Lawson 83-yard touchdown play is the longest play from scrimmage since a 90-yard touchdown run by Yonus Davis against Louisiana Tech in 2006.

Chandler Jones' 77-yard touchdown play was his 20th career touchdown reception.

Jimmy Pruitt came up with his first interception of the season in the third quarter. Bene Benewikere added a second interception in the fourth quarter. After not intercepting a pass in its three losses, the Spartans have five inteceptions in the last two games.

David Fales passed for more than 300 yards for the fourth game in a row and more 400 yards for the second time this season. Fales moved into eighth place on the San Jose State list for career total offense with 5,999 yards.

For the second week in a row, freshman wide receiver Tyler Winston had at least 150 pass receiving yards and a touchdown. Winston caught a season-high 8 passes for 151 yards and the game-winning touchdown of 62 yards with 5:36 to go in the game.

Running back Jarrod Lawson accounted for a 2013 team-best 202 yards of all-purpose running.
